BIBLIOGRAPHY

(A HANDY GUIDE TO GETTING IT WRITE RIGHT)

First, organize your authors alphabetically using their last names. (Do this manually on your rough draft or mentally before you type)

Next use the following format when you input your book resources.

Last name (comma) (space) first name (period) (2 spaces) Title of the book underlined and each word starting with capitals (period)(2 spaces) City it was published (colon)(space) Publisher (comma)(space) date it was published (period)

Example:

Adamson, Barney. The Story Of The World. Winnipeg: University Press, 2000.

Dickson, Adam. So The Story Goes. Pittsburgh: Phantom, 2004.

Simonson, Terri. The Trouble With Preteens. London, Ont.: Random, 1880.

If you are using a **magazine article** place it among the books in alphabetical order and use this format:

The author of the article's last name (comma) (space) First name (period)(double space) (quotation mark) title of the article (period)(quotation mark)(double space) Title of the magazine underlined (period)(double space) month of publication (period) (double space) year of publication (colon)(space) page numbers (period)

Example:

Olafson, Paul. "Why Am I So Itchy?" National Health Magazine. Jan. 2001: 22-25

It you are using a **website** place it amongst the other texts in alphabetical order and use this format:

The website's author/editor's last name (comma) (space) first name (period)(double space) (quotation mark) Title of the article (period)(quotation mark) (double space) Name of the website (period) (double space) day, month, year it was last accessed (space) website address in brackets (period)

Example:

Stewart, Martha. "I'm Innocent!" Living Well. Oct 27, 2004 (www.marthastewart.com).
