The Conferences

The Charlottetown Conference (Sept. 1864)

- Organized to discuss Maritime Union
- Representatives from Canada's crash the meetings
- Agreement to discuss wider union

The Quebec Conference (Oct. 1864)

- Came up with a plan for confederation
- Provincial + Federal Powers were agreed upon
- Intercontinental Railway was promised
- Drafted a series (72) resolutions

***Colonies pass resolutions

The London Conference (Dec. 1866-March 1867)

- Draft British North America Act
- The Act was passed in both houses of parliament
- July 1, 1867 marked the Dominion of Canada
- Ontario, Quebec, Nova Scotia, and New Brunswick
- Renamed the Constitution Act in 1982
