3. RULES

- a) by category? (Are You Smarter than a Canadian Sixth Grader?)
- b) by point/\$\$\$ value? (Canadian Jeopardy)
- c) by difficulty (Who Wants to be a Canadian Millionaire?)
- What type of "life lines" do you have (have 2 to pick from)
 ***Ask a friend, 50/50, Copy, Peek, Next Question, 2nd Chance, etc...
- Do you need other rules?
- ***Time Limit? Cheaters? Others???

4. PRIZES

- How do contestants win prizes? (3 stages towards better prizes)
- What do they win? (pins, stickers, tattoos, flags, Tim Hortons?)

 per for each game + final Jeopardy!
